Tucked into the heart of the Somerset village of South Petherton, The David Hall is one of the South West's most cherished small venues. Known as **"the small hall with the BIG reputation,"** this Grade II-listed space has welcomed world-class folk, roots, blues and acoustic music since 1986, alongside theatre, film and community events.

Named in memory of David Hall, whose father Brian bought the former church in the 1980s, the venue has carried his name since Petherton Arts Trust leased it in 1989.

Run as a volunteer-led charity, The David Hall is proud to support both grassroots and established artists and to keep live performance thriving in rural Somerset.

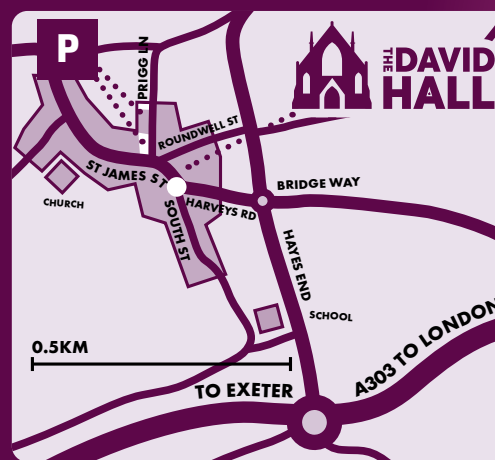

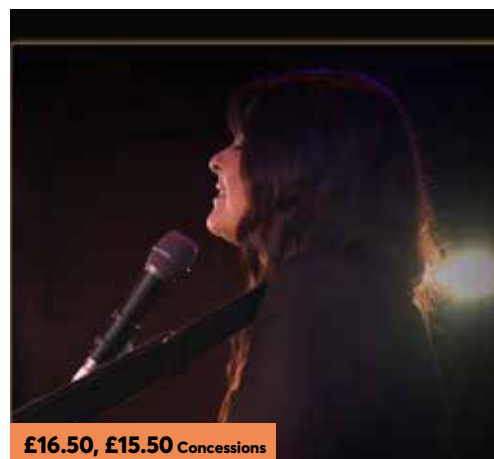

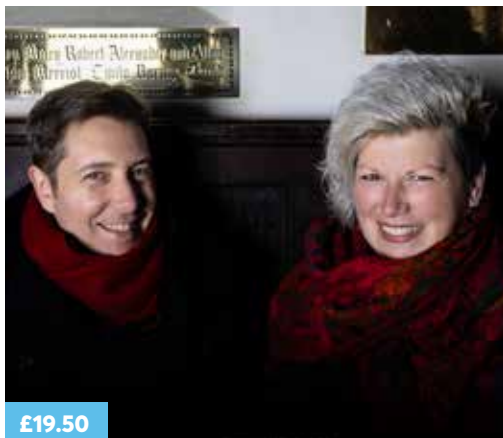
